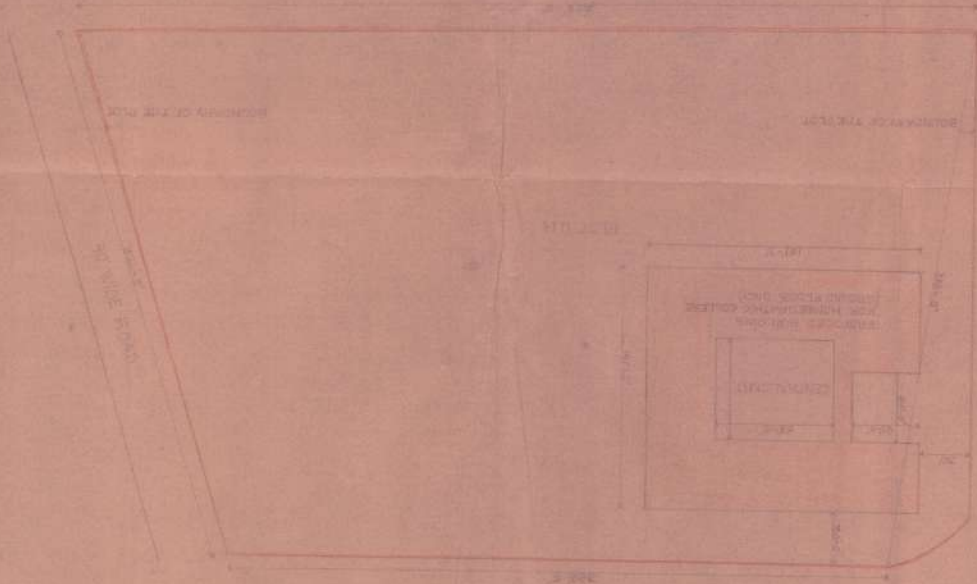

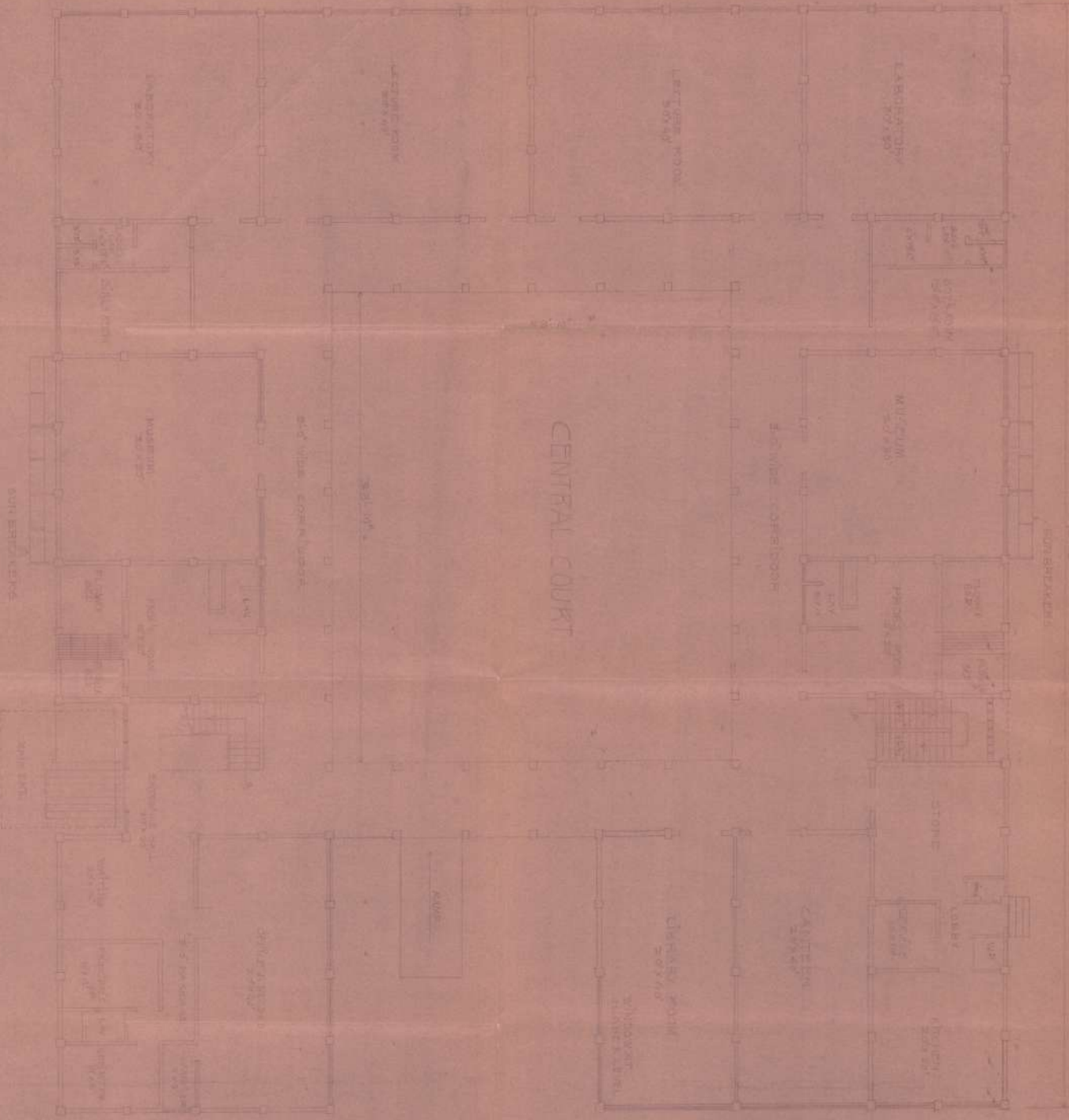

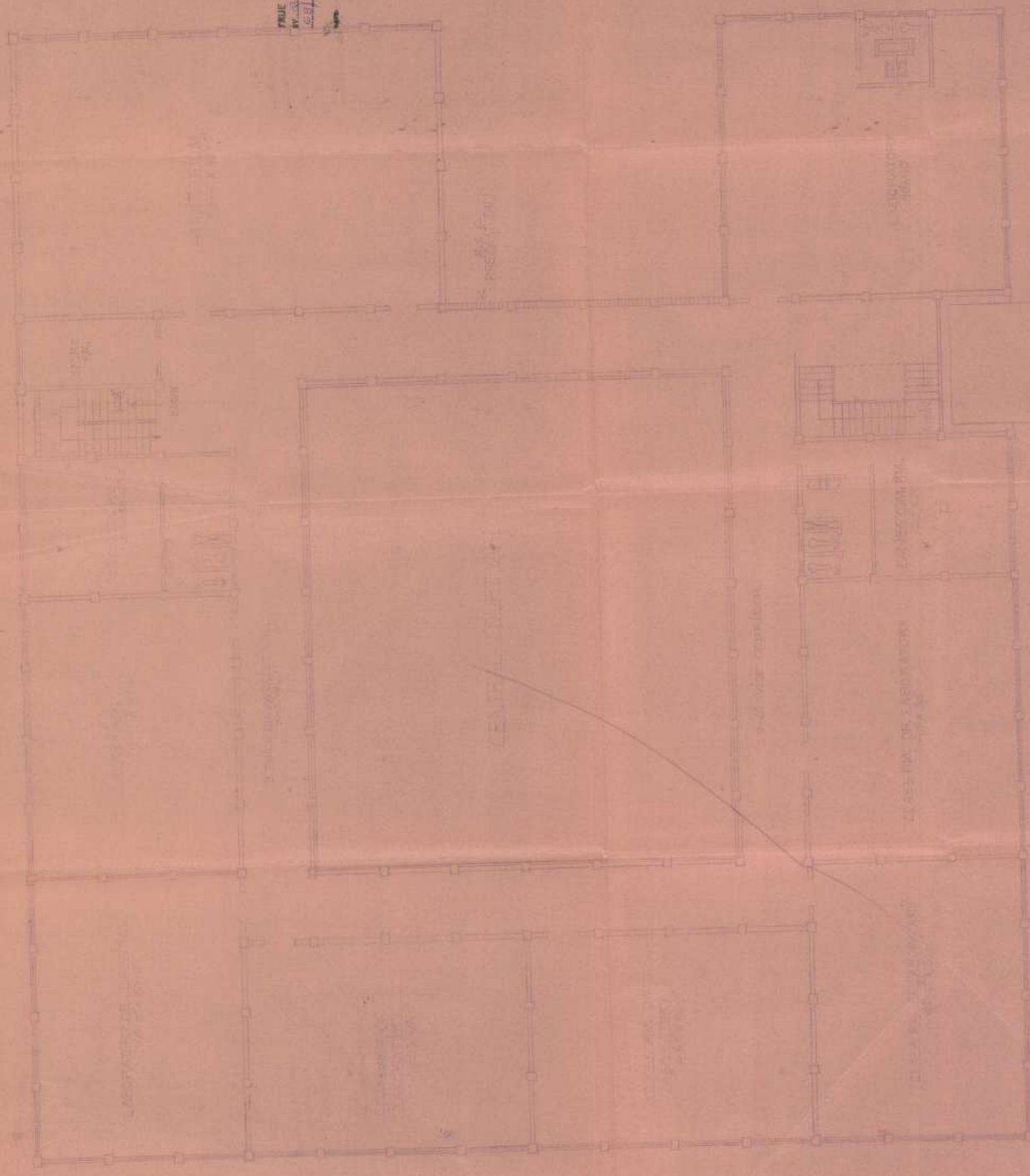


GROUND FLOOR PLAN

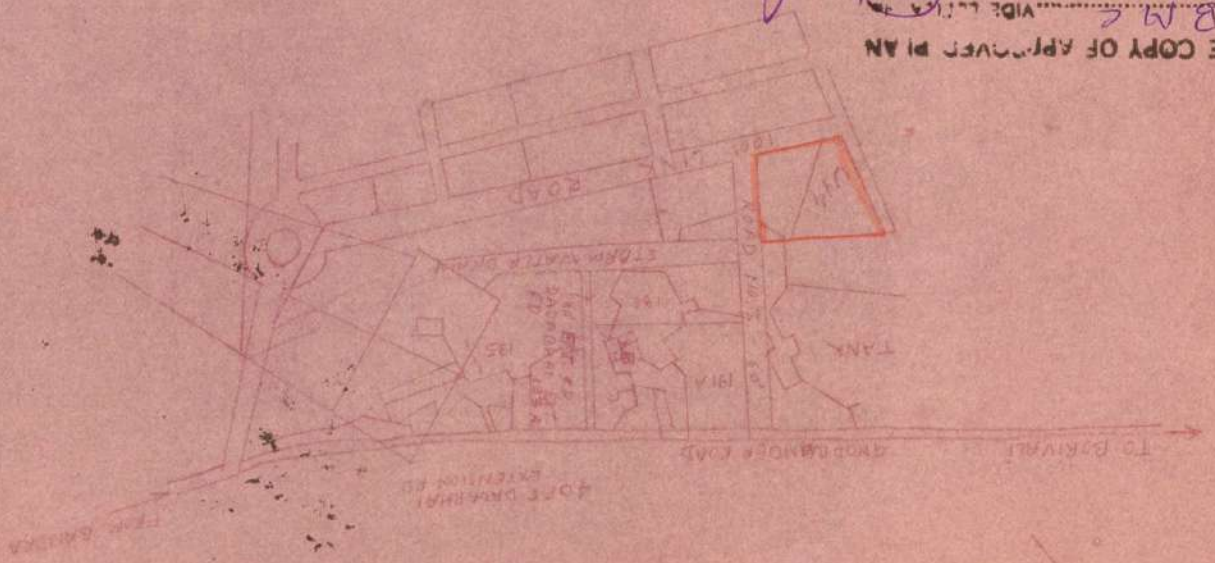

MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION

of

The Homoeopathic Education Society

1. **Name** : The name of the Organisation (hereinafter called "The society") shall be "The Homoeopathic Education Society."
2. **Sphere of Operation** : The activity of the Society shall extended to the whole of India.
3. **Aims and Objects** : The aims and objects for which the Society has been established are :
 - (a) To promote, encourage and assist the science and art of Homoeopathic system of medicine.
 - (b) To promote interaction and exchange of views amongst the medical men of all systems of medicine generally and between its members in particular.
 - (c) To arrange and provide facilities for lectures, conferences, social functions, exhibitions, demonstrations and such other opportunities for propagating the Homoeopathics system of medicine.
 - (d) To maintain and safeguard the material interest and status of the Homoeopathic Medical Profession.
 - (e) To promote and establish branches of the Society all over India.
 - (f) To enter into working arrangement of any kind with other organisations having objects wholly or partly similar to those of the Society which may be deemed available or beneficial in the interest of the Society or the Homoeopathic System of Medicine.

- (g) To enter into any arrangements with the Governments, local authority and other quasi Government bodies, and other public or private bodies in order to promote and achieve any or all the aims and objects of the Society.
- (h) To move for enactment and for enforcement of the necessary medical laws, especially to secure the general recognition and acceptance of Homoeopathy.
- (i) To alleviate the sufferings of the poor by establishing dispensaries or hospitals of all systems of medicine or similar institutions.
- (j) To promote, improve, control, diffuse and impart medical knowledge in systematic and scientific Homoeopathic education by establishing, maintaining, supervising and controlling schools, colleges, technical research classes and laboratories, hostels and boarding houses for students in Homoeopathy.
- (k) To establish or take over and conduct hospitals of all systems of medicine for the purpose of imparting training in practical course to students receiving education and/or training in Homoeopathy and provide them exposure in all systems of medicine.
- (l) To provide for research work in Homoeopathy.
- (m) To provide for an conduct examinations in the science and art of Homoeopathy and to confer certificates, diplomas, titles and other marks of honour on any person or persons.
- (n) To establish and maintain a library.
- (o) To publish an official journal of the Society and to bring out any circulars, periodicals, booklets, leaflets, etc., to advance any or all the aims and objects of the Society.

- (p) To accept any property by way of gift or otherwise for any one or more objects of the Society.
- (q) To purchase, take on lease, hire or otherwise acquire or hold movable or immovable property, rights and privileges and to improve and develop any or all of them for the purposes of the Society.
- (r) To sell or give on hire, movable or immovable properties to sell the rights and privileges to build and develop any of the property for the purposes of the Society.
- (s) To borrow or secure the payment of money which may be required for the Society and to invest or otherwise deal with the moneys towards the promotion of the objects of the Society in such manner as may be decided upon from time to time.
- (t) And generally to do all such things as may be deemed incidental or conducive to the attainment of all or any of the objects for which the Society is established.

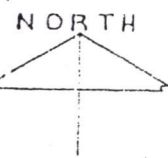
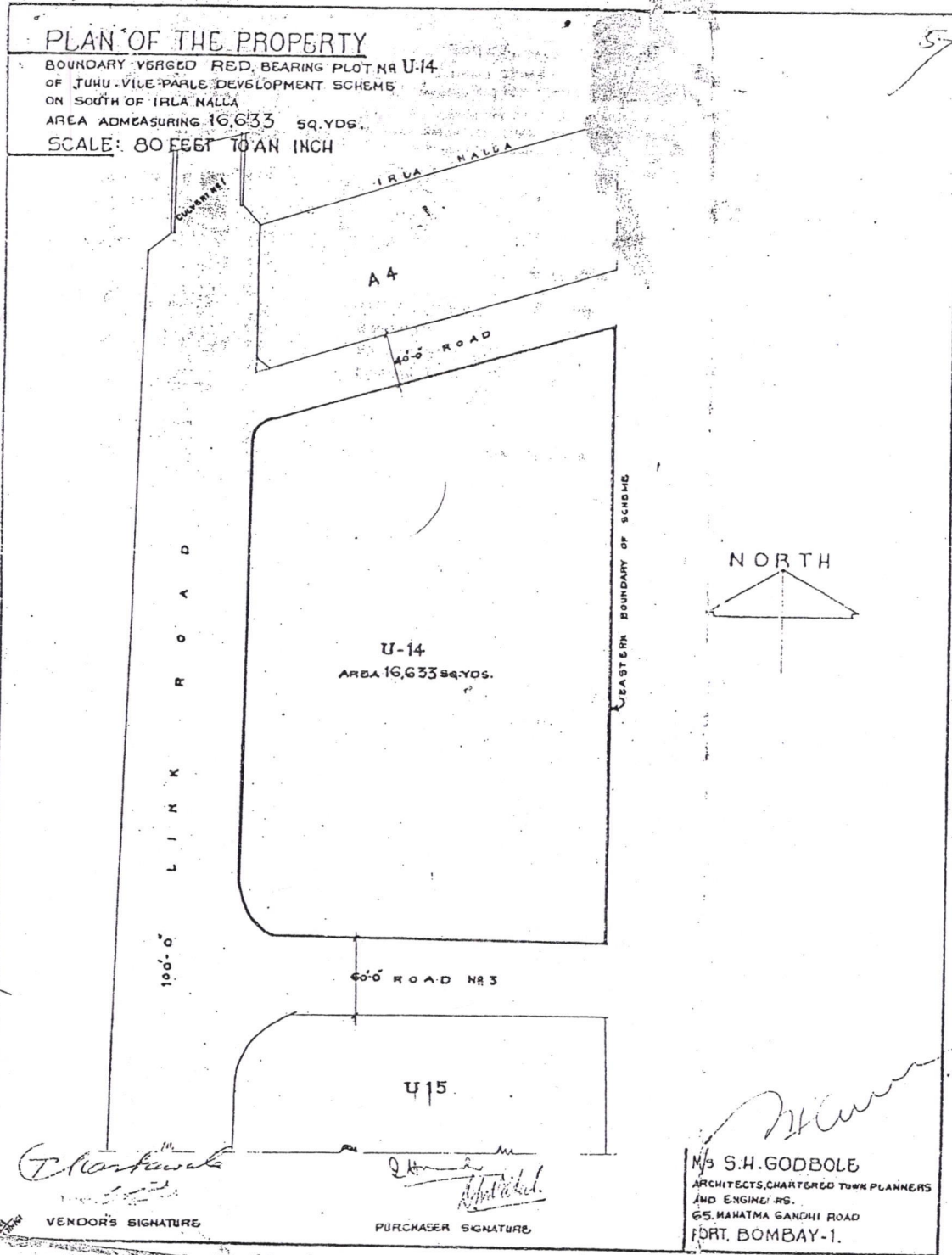

WHEREAS the Government of Bombay at the request of certain
Co-operative Housing Societies acquired all those pieces or --
parcels of Khajan land in the villages of Juhu and Vile Parle in
the Bombay Suburban District, South Salsette Taluka, admeasuring
in the aggregate 426 Acres 23 Gunthas and 1.34 ans. or thereabouts
more particularly described with their respective numbers in the
first Schedule hereunder written to be allotted to certain co-
operative Housing Societies which had agreed to pay the cost of

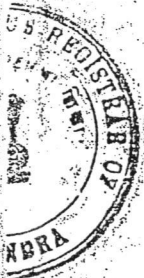
acquisition and development of the said lands for the purpose of housing Schemes.

AND WHEREAS on acquisition of the said lands as aforesaid the Special Land Acquisition Officer, Government of Bombay, -- delivered possession thereof to the Bombay Housing Board constituted under the Bombay Act LXIX of 1948 so as to vest the same in the Board.

AND WHEREAS the Government of Bombay by its Resolution No. 383/48 in the Labour Department dated the 15th day of March 1949 in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Section 24(p) of the said Act, declared that in its opinion it was expedient to make provision with a view to provide housing accommodation and to the improvement and development of the said lands and for that purpose specified the laying out and developing of the said lands.

AND WHEREAS the Government of Bombay, Labour and Housing Department, by its Order No. 119/48 dated the 14th day of May 1951 sanctioned the said Scheme for laying out and developing of the said lands for the purpose of allotment thereof to the Co-operative Housing Societies and entrusted the work of the execution of the said Scheme to the said Board and exempted at the request of the said Board the whole of the said Scheme from the provisions of Sections 26 to 33 (both inclusive) of the said Act.

AND WHEREAS in pursuance of the said Scheme the said Board with the approval of the Government of Bombay, Labour and Housing Department as expressed by their letter No. 119/48/26596-F dated the 31st day of July 1952 marked out building plots for allotment to Co-operative Housing Societies, demarcated and constructed roads and also marked out plots for general amenities and public utility purpose to be owned in common by the Co-operative Housing Societies participating in the said Scheme both on the left bank and on the right bank of the Irla Nalla running through the said lands in the proportion that the area of the building plots -- allotted to each Society on the left bank and on the right bank of

of the said Irla Nalla respectively bears to the total building area on the left bank and of the right bank of the said Irla Nalla respectively.

AND WHEREAS the Government of Bombay, Development -- Department, by its letter No. JDS/1155/17015-H dated the 1st day of June 1955 approved the final lay-out of the said Scheme and the allotment of building plots to the respective Co-operative Housing Societies and also the distribution of areas occupied by roads, canalisation, creeks and common amenities and public utility plots as between the Co-operative Housing Societies located on the left bank of the said Irla Nalla on the one hand and that located on the right bank of the said Irla Nalla on the other hand with the Irla Nalla as the common boundary line between the two

AND WHEREAS the Lessors being the fourteen Co-operative Housing Societies located on the left bank of the said Irla Nalla have paid to the said Board the costs payable by them respectively of the acquisition and the development of the said lands on the left bank of the said Irla Nalla including the cost of earth filling, construction of roads, canalisation

AND WHEREAS the said Board has executed Conveyances in favour of the Lessors of the respective building plots allotted to them respectively as aforesaid and has also delivered to them respectively vacant possession thereof.

AND WHEREAS the said Board has agreed with the Lessors to execute at the cost of the Lessors the remaining work of development, namely, the construction of 40 feet internal roads in the said Scheme.

AND WHEREAS by an Indenture of Conveyance dated the 26th day of April 1960 and made between the said Board of the one part and the Lessors of the other part and registered with the Sub-Registrar of Bandra on the 19th day of July 1960 under Serial No. 1436, the said Board for the consideration therein mentioned



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granted, conveyed and assured unto the Lessors ALL those pieces or parcels of vacant lands being the several amenity plots and the several Utility plots including the Plot No. U/14 hereby demised by the Lessors unto the Lessees and also the 40' internal roads, canalisation and creeks of the said Juhu-Vile Parle Development Scheme particularly described in the third Schedule thereunder written and delineated on the plans II and III/1 to III/23 thereto annexed to be held by the Lessors as tenants-in-common with their respective shares therein as hereinabove mentioned.

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AND WHEREAS by the said Indenture of Conveyance dated the 26th day of April 1960 the Lessors have covenanted with the said Board that the Lessors shall pay to the said Board the balance of the cost and shall discharge all liabilities in respect of the development of the said lands as provided in the hereinabove recited respective Conveyances executed by the said Board in favour of the Lessors and shall also pay all rents taxes assessments, dues and duties from the respective dates of the said Conveyance to the State of Maharashtra or to the Bombay Municipal Corporation or any other public or a local body in respect of the said lands and that the Lessors shall also absolve the said Board from all liabilities of and incidental to the execution of the said Scheme.



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AND WHEREAS the Lessees are ~~XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX~~ ~~XXXXXXXXXXXX~~ of the Homoeopathic Education Society registered under the Societies Registration Act of 1860 and having for its objects among others of imparting education in homoeopathic science and establishing Homoeopathic Hospital

AND WHEREAS the Lessees have applied to the Lessors for the grant to them of a Lease of one of the said Utility Plots belonging to the Lessors being Plot No. U14 admeasuring 16633 Sq. Yds. or thereabouts more particularly described in the second Schedule hereunder written and delineated on the plan hereto -- annexed

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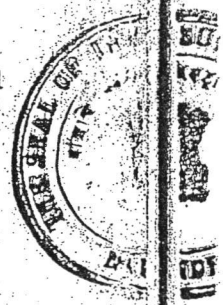

AND WHEREAS the Lessors considering the fact that the Lessees were a public Institution and the land was to be utilised for establishing a Homoeopathic College, Hostel and Hospital beneficial to the residents in the said Societies agreed to grant to the Lessees a lease of the said premises more particularly described in the second Schedule hereunder written at a concessional price of Rs 13/- per square yard on the terms and conditions hereinafter mentioned

NOW THIS INDENTURE WITNESSETH as follows:-

1. In consideration of the sum of Rs 2,16,229/- (Rupees Two lacs sixteen thousand two hundred twenty nine only) paid by the Lessees to the Lessors (the receipt whereof the Lessors do hereby acknowledge) and of the rent and the covenants hereinafter reserved and contained the Lessors do hereby demise unto the Lessees all that piece or parcel of land situate at Vile Parle in Greater Bombay being plot No. U14 on the left bank of Irla Nalla of the Juhu-Vile Parle Development Scheme more particularly described in the second Schedule hereunder written and delineated on the plan hereto annexed and shown thereon by a boundary line coloured red TOGETHER with the right in common with the Lessors and all the respective members of the Lessors and the occupiers of the adjoining premises to use for all purposes the roads and passages and also the channels, water-courses, sewers and drains upon or under the demised premises or any part or parts thereof made to be made hereafter by or for the accommodation of the Lessors and their respective members TO HOLD the premises hereby demised or expressed so to be (hereinafter referred to as " the demised premises") unto the Lessees from the 5th day of July 1960 for the term of 999 years paying therefor during the said term yearly on the 4th day of July in such and every year the rent of Re. 1/- whether demanded or not.

2. The Lessees for themselves their successors and assigns and



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and to the intent that the obligations may continue throughout the term hereby created hereby covenant with the Lessors as -- follows:-

- (1) To pay to the Lessors the reserved Rent on the dates and in the manner aforesaid without any deduction or abatement whatsoever therefrom.
- (2) To bear, pay and discharge all existing and future rates, taxes, assessments, duties, impositions and outgoings assessed, imposed or charged upon the -- demised premises or on the rent therefor upon the owner or occupier in respect thereof by the Municipality or the State of Maharashtra or any other local or public body.
- (3) To observe, comply with and satisfy all regulations, bye-laws rules and conditions now or at any time hereafter to be prescribed by Government or by any local or public authority with regard to the use and -- occupation of the demised premises.

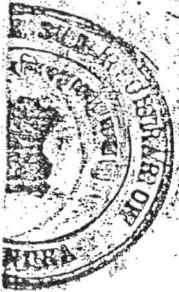

- (7) To keep the compound and open spaces of the demised premises in a clean and sanitary condition and not to allow the same to be overgrown with weeds and rank vegetation and to keep the hedges and fences in proper order and repair.
- (8) To permit the Lessors and their agents at all reasonable times to enter upon the demised premises and to view and examine the condition thereof and upon the Lessors or their Agents giving or leaving notice in writing of any defects or want of repairs, to repair and make good the same within a reasonable time.
